SPORT – U13 Team Table Tennis (Separate boys and girls competitions)	
ELIGIBILITY	
Age Group	School Years: U13
Eligibility	<p>Only school teams can enter the competition (not representative school teams)</p> <p>All participating Schools and Colleges must be within the county of Wiltshire.</p>
TEAM REQUIREMENTS	
Team size on the day	4 players— each player within a team must be ranked on ability, from 1 to 4. One reserve is permitted into the competition.
EVENT FORMAT & RULES	
Event to be played to The English Table Tennis Association’s rules	<p>The competition shall be governed in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the ETTA.</p> <p>Indoor sports shoes MUST be worn.</p>
Format of competition	<p>A match shall consist of 8 sets (all of which must be played) with each set being the best of 5 games (first to eleven) *depending on the size of entry. Each player will play 2 individual games.</p> <p>The No 1 Ranked Player will play Players ranked 2 & 1 The No 2 Ranked Player will play players ranked 1 & 2 The No 3 Ranked Player will play players ranked 4 & 3 The No 4 Ranked Player will play players ranked 3 & 4</p>

SPORT – U13 Team Table Tennis (Separate boys and girls competitions)	
Format of Competition cont.	<p>In the group system, 2 match points shall be awarded to the winning team, and 1 match point to each team for a draw (4-4 in sets regardless of games). The group position shall be decided primarily by the match points gained.</p> <p>If 2 or more teams have gained the same number of match points, their relative positions shall be determined by the results only of the matches played between those being equal, sets ratio, games ratio and, if necessary, points ratio.</p> <p>All matches in the Championships shall be played under the Laws of Table Tennis as adopted by the English Table Tennis Association.</p>
Team/player no show rules during competition	If a team does not show for the whole match then the opposition are awarded a win, 5-3
Substitutions	Reserves may be used in case of injury. If a player is injured during a game then that game is conceded, but a reserve may be substituted for further games and/or matches.
Infringement of Min/ max number in team	<p>If more than 5 player or ineligible players are brought, they will not be allowed to play.</p> <p>If ineligible players are played then the team will be disqualified from the competition.</p>
Grievance procedures	If these relate to the sport specific tournament they must be made to the Tournament Organiser.
Timescale for Competition	Zone Competition: September—November

TT Networker—Table Tennis Leadership Award

Age requirements: 15-18 years old

Time requirements 6 hours.

Course aims and objectives

The award, aimed at 15-18 year olds, gives candidates an opportunity to experience and learn about the variety of volunteering opportunities in Table Tennis clubs, leagues and schools.

The main aims of the six hour course are to enable the leaders to organise safe, enjoyable and purposeful activities aimed primarily at young people, and to provide a lead into Table Tennis coaching, organising competitions, umpiring and development of the sport.

As part of the course, young leaders plan and deliver the new Butterfly Skills Circuit, which is an integral part of the Butterfly Skills Programme.

Delivery Requirements (i.e. Who can deliver the course and what qualifications / training do they need?)

ETTA Regional Development Officer will appoint a tutor for each course.

What does the young person obtain? (e.g. certificate)

Certificate of attendance.

Assessment: Candidates will be formatively assessed throughout the course.

Refresher: No refresher required.

Suggested additional learning opportunities: Junior Umpire Award

Cost details £15 per candidate (incl resource) plus £90 for the tutor fees and travel at 26p per mile.
